CREDENTIALS COMMITTEE

This committee is responsible for handling any discrepancies or changes in the processing of credentials. It is the responsibility of this committee to issue any ruling on a disputed credential and keep track of the number of delegates and report this to the convention. Being on this committee requires a high level of commitment.

ELECTIONS COMMITTEE

This committee is responsible for conducting the Council 32 officers and executive board elections during the convention. This committee is also responsible for conducting any roll call votes on resolutions or constitutional amendments. Members of the elections committee may not be candidates for any officer or executive board positions. Being on this committee requires a high level of commitment.

RULES OF ORDER COMMITTEE

This committee is responsible for reviewing the rules for conducting the convention. Meets only once during the convention.

SERGEANT-AT-ARMS COMMITTEE

This committee is responsible for making sure that convention delegates are the only members on the convention floor when convention is in session. Sergeant-at-Arms directs guests and observers to their designated seating area. Committee members are also responsible for counting the number of votes when voting occurs on the floor of the convention. Other duties include enforcing convention rules, providing security, controlling the noise level on the convention floor, collecting and distributing all authorized convention materials, and are the official timekeepers during debate. Other duties may also be assigned as directed by the Council President. A commitment of a select time during the convention will be requested at the first meeting.
