Voting members of the Wisconsin PEOPLE Conference is comprised AFSCME International Vice President from Wisconsin, the President of Wisconsin AFSCME Council 32, the Senate District representatives, and a retiree representative. The conference meets on an as needed basis.

As defined in the conference constitution: the Senate District Chairpersons in each Senate District shall be responsible for member mobilization for endorsed candidates in each respective Senate District and for providing general leadership and coordination of activities necessary to carry out the objectives of this Conference.

## ARTICLE II OBJECTIVES AND METHODS

- Section 1 This Conference shall have as its objective the carrying on of successful political and legislative action programs designed to meet the needs of AFSCME affiliates and members in the State of Wisconsin.
- Section 2 These objectives shall be carried out in the following manner.
- A. By developing and advocating state legislative programs in the interests of AFSCME members.
- B. By carrying out programs designed to educate voters concerning the records and platforms of political candidates.
- C. By engaging in active voter registration and get-out-the-vote campaigns among AFSCME members and their families.
- D. By providing training programs to better enable AFSCME members in Wisconsin to engage in effective political and legislative programs, and by encouraging the highest possible degree of membership participation in such programs.
- E. By endorsing and actively supporting candidates for public office at all levels in cooperation with the county, congressional, senate district, and national PEOPLE committees.
